Drilling of Borehole and installation of drip irrigation systems in school garden at Kipanga, Mole Kiloleni, and Kamata Namba 3 Primary Schools in Sikonge District, Tabora

The People's Care Initiative-Tanzania (PCI-T) is a Non-profit, Non-partisan, non-religious organization dedicated to collaborating with existing local structures and communities to address economic hardships, hunger, diseases, and human rights violations by implementing sustainable, practical solutions that foster healthy, skilled, and innovative communities across Tanzania and beyond. People's Care Initiatives - Tanzania (PCI-T) is implementing the School Feeding and After-School Activities Program (Feed and Nurture Project), funded by Phillip Morris International (PMI) and MKWAWA Leaf Tobacco (MLT), in the Mkwawa leaf tobacco-growing areas. The project is currently being implemented in Sikonge District, Tabora, Tanzania. The primary objective of this project is to address the issue of child labor in Tanzania's tobacco-growing regions by providing a holistic solution that combines a school feeding program with structured after-school activities. The project aims to create a supportive learning environment that promotes school attendance, improves nutritional and academic outcomes, and reduces child labor.

Tender Expression

People's Care Initiatives invites qualified and reputable drilling contractors to drill the borehole and set the irrigation system in the school garden in three schools, namely Kipanga Primary School at Mibono village, 40km from Sikonge District center, Kamatta No.3 at Mwenge village, 170km from Sikonge District center, Mole Kiloleni at Mole Kiloleni Village, 18km from Sikonge District center along Urambo District shortcut road, all in Tabora region

Scope of Work

The works shall include, but not be limited to, the attached BOQ

2. Scope of Work

The works shall include, but not be limited to:

- Hydrogeological survey and borehole siting.
- Drilling, casing, and development of productive boreholes.
- Pump installation (solar-powered).
- Construction of elevated water storage tanks and connection systems.
- Installation of drip irrigation systems in designated school gardens.
- Training of school/community representatives on system use and maintenance.
